Pimento

Pimento (All spice) primarily comes from Mexico. Honduras, Jamaica and Guatemala also produce small quantities with high Volatile oils. The crop in Mexico last year (Sept 06) was around 5,000 mt and this years crop is expected to be around 4000 – 5000 mt, possibly smaller than 06. Prices have remained flat for 6 months and will possibly ease a little up to the new crop in Sept this year. We supply three grades: Ground Pimento, UK re-cleaned Whole Pimento (for packing) and FAQ max 1% Whole Pimento.



Pink Pepper season starts in Brazil

Brazilian harvesting of Pink Pepper started this month under predictions of unfavourable conditions, according the reports received today from exporters. Weather, government protection actions, among other factors, indicate that this crop could be reduced by some 50% compared to the 2006 year. Exporters are reporting difficulties in collecting reasonable quantities of good quality pepper and expect a drastic reduction in the output. Exporters are talking about a minimum **US\$ 14,00 per kg F.O.B Brazil for First Grade Pepper**. This works out at around £7.90 / kg as a cost in UK.



Markets
